Learning Factories

Learning factories are a promising move to competence and skill development. The linking of learning strategies and latest trends in manufacturing empower training, research and education in different areas of engineering. The Learning Factory and Activity Based Learning model changes the physical infrastructure and didactic structure of the practices of manufacturing engineering towards learning factory concept. The proposed model is based on the three important premises.

1. Access to capstone technology anytime.
2. Guidance from experts
3. Risk immunization for learners (breakages/damages).

These premises which are a set of characteristics must be developed to achieve a successful Learning factory.

In its maiden launch, the institute set up a Learning factory in the year 2018 in the mechanical engineering workshop

with a Vertical milling machine, CNC turning, 3D printing, laser cutting, table top milling machine and other power tools other than the conventional lathe, drilling and sheet metal cutting machines. These machines are available to all the students of the engineering colleges beyond working hours so that they can plan their innovation ideas, get the approval from their mentor and start the work. The learning factory gave the students a platform to try their engineering ideas in a constraint free environment. The process is depicted in the figure below.

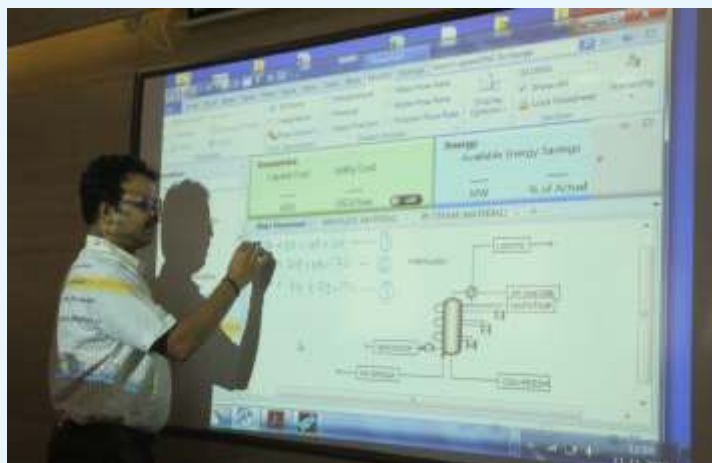
Mock Interview for Final Year Students
