Vocabulary building by learning the new words with meanings and their usage in sentence formation, learning 5 new words daily. Images, audio and video to depict the usage of new words and catch up with oral communication. Exercises like copy writing, fill up the blanks, crossword. Teaching spellings/grammar structure w.r.t. a known Indian language ( Hindi preferred)	Any Kannada material	The student shall have learnt the usage of Kannada pronouns, question words, words of negation, family relationship names, cases ( vibkathi prataya ), adjectives in learning the lessons on basic introduction and day-to-day conversation.

4	Lessons 16 to 20	Student to watch Kannada TV programs and communicate in Kannada whenever possible	5	Same methodology as mentioned above. Additional reading beginning with basic sentences, small stories. Answering orally and writing practice of the exercise questions following the lessons.	Any Kannada material	The student shall have learnt the usage of Kannada continuous tenses, future tenses, negating sentences, occupation names, conditional forms of verbs. The student shall be able to read fluently Kannada script.
5	Kannada Script	Student to watch Kannada TV programs and communicate in Kannada whenever possible	15	Learn the Kannada alphabet set by repeated copy writing, writing of words and sentences( basic alphabet set, 'kaaguNitha', 'orthakshara' ) Learn the pronunciation of each letter by framing words beginning with these letters. English lettered notation to be used as key to transcription ( e.g. 'ee' denotes the pronunciation as 'keep', 'uu' for 'moon' ) Letter grouping to distinguish similar-shaped letters of the alphabet.	Additional practice through use of apps and online editors	The student shall be able to write the Kannada script
