



BE Freshman Engineering I Semester % of Passing (Section-wise)





BE I Semester Jan 2015 & Jan 2016 Examination Results (Branch-wise)








SGPA Analysis of B.E. I Semester Jan 2016 Examination (Mechanical Sciences)




SGPA Analysis of I Semester Jan 2016 Examination (Electrical Sciences)




SGPA Comparison of B.E. I Semester Jan 2015 & Jan 2016 Examination




Bachelor of Architecture I Semester % of Passing




SGPA Analysis of Bachelor of Architecture I Semester Jan 2016 Examination




MBA I Semester % of Passing




SGPA Analysis of MBA I Semester Jan 2016 Examination




MBA I Semester Jan 2015 & Jan 2016 Examination Results




MCA I Semester % of Passing




SGPA Analysis of MCA I Semester Jan 2016 Examination
